

BIBLIOGRAPHY

Primary sources began with the many taped and transcribed interviews with Chito conducted during the last years of his life. Primary sources also included such interviews with Jeanette Longoria, Maria Teresa de Escobar, Ferro Pagliai, Federico Longoria, Aurora Rosales, and George H. Link.

Primary sources included over one hundred thousand document obtained in connection with the United States law suits and the original deposition transcripts of over thirty people which embodied over ten thousand pages of sworn testimony. Primary sources also included regular and frequent discussions with Jeanette Longoria and George H. Link, with whom the writer discussed pieces of the puzzle as it emerged.

As discussed above, Chito gave the writer access to all of the otherwise privileged material pertaining to the many law suits, including his communication with his attorneys and his attorneys' work product, which constituted an additional primary source. Chito shipped to the writer all of his own records pertaining to his industrial and banking businesses as well as his personal

correspondence. Of course, all of these primary sources were invaluable in the creation of this interpretation of his life.

Secondary sources relevant to Chito's life in Northern Mexico, his dealings with successive Mexican governments, and the economic trends that impacted his business successes and failures were found at the Graduate Research Library at UCLA, the Library of Congress, Archivo General de Nación (AGN, Mexico), Archivos de Estado de Tamaulipas, and the Bancroft Library at the University of California at Berkeley. Additional secondary sources, including articles and sometimes obscure papers, were readily supplied to the writer by her supportive faculty advisor. Additional sources of secondary material were the electronic devices now available to extract news media data.

In the bibliography that follows, primary sources are identified in the form that they are maintained in the writer's collection.
